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## Percussion Patterns

2. Music is generally written within some type of pattern.  
When you are composing and arranging this pattern is called  
the **FORM** of the music.

Here are some different sections that can be in a song.  
With your friends, decide which meanings match each section.

- Introduction** - the beginning of a song 
- Verse** - a section of a song that tells part of its story 
- Chorus** - the repeated part of a song 
- Coda** - the ending of a song 



Listen to the song on the CD. Draw a triangle when you hear an introduction. Draw a square when you hear a verse. Draw a circle when you hear a chorus and draw a star when you hear an ending.

See if you had the same answers as your friends. This is a song in a verse and chorus form. It also has a beginning and an ending.
