## Bongos, Tambourine and Bass Drum

4. Now for the bongo, tambourine and drum players. Follow these helpful hints if you cannot read the music:



### Bongo

- Say the words bon-go, bon-go in each bar.
- It will match the rhythm in bar 1.
- You will tap twice on the first 'go'.
- When you see 'sh', it is a rest.

### Tambourine

### Bass Drum
