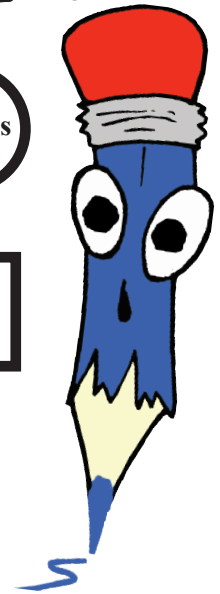
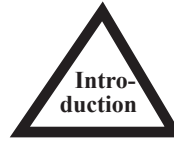
MIDDLE REVIEW

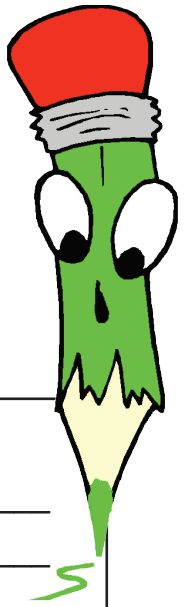

Task 4. Investigate a person, band or group whose music you like. Use these headings to help you find out about them. In the frame below, paste or draw a picture of the band.

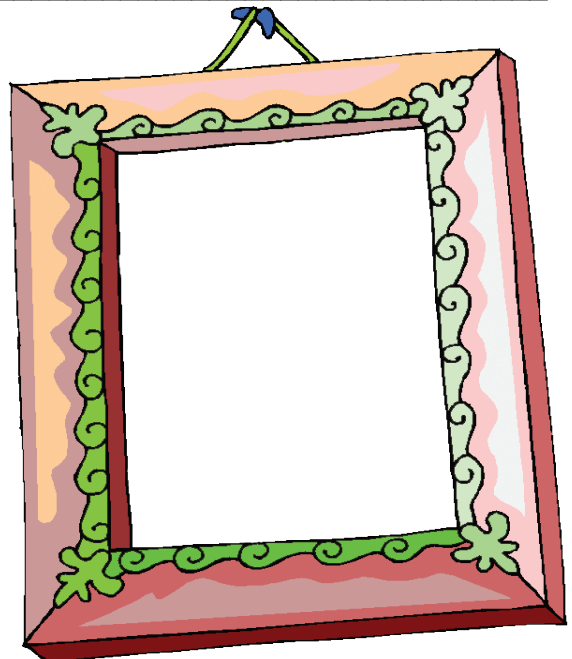
