

\* Pop music group      \* Close vocal harmonies      \* Started in California, USA 1961


\* Many top forty hits and best-selling albums

**Task 3.** Major chords are considered happier chords than minor chords. Play these chords and decide if they are **major** or **minor**:





C E G = C Major

G B D = G \_\_\_\_\_

F A C = F \_\_\_\_\_

D F# A = G \_\_\_\_\_

(you can change the F for an F# on most xylophones)



C E $\flat$  G = C Minor

G B $\flat$  D = G \_\_\_\_\_

(E $\flat$  - E flat is the black key just to the left of the E key)

F A $\flat$  C = F \_\_\_\_\_

D F A = G \_\_\_\_\_

**Task 4.** Who can sing the theme from the 'Simpsons'? Name a song from a Disney movie. What would a cartoon be without music? Think of your favourite television show. Can you hum the opening music?
